

RECYCLED CRAYONS

Recycle your old crayons to make new ones unique to you! Use molds in different shapes to create a personalized coloring experience—all from the power of the Sun.

SUPPLIES

- Unwrapped crayons or pieces of old crayons
- Silicone mold or a Dixie cup
- The Sun!

ACTIVITY

- 1. Make sure all crayons have the wrappers removed.
- 2. Break crayons into small pieces, or use small or broken crayons. Adults can use a cheese grater to get crayons into smaller pieces.
- 3. Place crayon pieces into the mold or Dixie cup.
- 4. Put molds or cups outside on a sunny day. Leave out for 2-4 hours, or until they have fully melted.
- 5. Once melted, bring inside and allow them to cool.
- 6. Once the crayons have hardened, take them out of the mold.
- 7. Use your new Crayons on your next coloring project!
